How to build an Observatory – the people and birds that made CBO

When CBO was founded in the mid-1950s, a tree was growing in the roofless shell of the same buildings where our common room can now be found. In 2015 we placed our fourth roof - a £10K state of the art, trapezoidal, insulated, fire-resistant frame – over the old 19th century lighthouse

keepers' cottages which CBO calls home. As the observatory enters its seventh decade, Peter Munro looks over some of the milestone events, characters, and birds who helped to write the CBO story. Peter's talk is illustrated with some stunning early colour slides including the original Radar installation, which was still standing in the 1950s.
